**Ordinance #12-05**

**Proposed Precinct Line Adjustment – Second Election District**

The Board of Supervisors of King William County, Virginia, will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, June 25, 2012 at 7:45 p.m. in the Board Meeting Room of the County Administration Building, 180 Horse Landing Road, King William, Virginia, to receive public comment and to consider adoption of an ordinance altering the voting precinct boundaries within in the Second Election District to match those established by the General Assembly for State elections. This adjustment will eliminate a split voting precinct.

A copy of a map depicting the new precinct boundaries as well as the Ordinance describing the districts and precincts is available for review in the Office of the County Administrator, King William County Administration Building, Monday through Friday, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.
