NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT AND PUBLIC HEARING**

**Ordinance #12-04
Proposed Dispatch Services Agreement**

The Board of Supervisors of King William County, Virginia, will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, June 25, 2012 at 7:45 p.m. in the Board Meeting Room of the County Administration Building, 180 Horse Landing Road, King William, Virginia, to receive public comment and to consider adoption of Ordinance #12-04.

Ordinance #12-04 will approve an agreement between the Town of West Point (Town), the County of King William (County), and the King William County Sheriff for the County to provide dispatch services to the Town for five (5) years at a cost of \$40,000 per year to the Town.

All interested persons may appear and present their views at the above time and place. If a member of the public cannot attend, comments may be submitted by mail to P. O.
