**Ordinance #13-05**

**Proposed Change of Polling Place – Sweet Hall Precinct (201)  
in the Second Election District**

The Board of Supervisors of King William County, Virginia, will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, May 20, 2013 at 7:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter, in the Board Meeting Room of the County Administration Building, 180 Horse Landing Road, King William, Virginia, to receive public comment and to consider an ordinance to adopt a change in the polling place for the Sweet Hall Precinct (201) for all Election purposes.

Ordinance #13-05 will change the sole polling place for the Sweet Hall Precinct (201) from the present location at VFW Post #8356, 1658 VFW Road, West Point, VA 23181 to Brett Reed Memorial Church, 29680 King William Road, West Point, VA 23181. This change is being made at the request of the King William County Electoral Board, and will not change any representation at the local, state or Federal level.

All interested persons may appear and present their views at the above time and place. If a member of the public cannot attend, comments may be submitted by mail to P. O.
