

KING WILLIAM COUNTY VIRGINIA

Notice of Public Hearing and Intent to Adopt Proposed Tax Levies for Calendar Year 2013 Ordinance #13-08

The Board of Supervisors of King William County, Virginia, will hold a Public Hearing on May 20, 2013, beginning at 7:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter, in the Board Meeting Room of the County Administration Building, 180 Horse Landing Road, King William, Virginia, for the purpose of accepting public comment and afterwards considering the adoption of Ordinance #13-08 to enact the following proposed property tax levies **(which represent an increase in the County tax rates for residents of the Town of West Point as shown below)** for Calendar Year 2013:

PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX LEVIES

2. Mobile Home (Vehicles without motive power, used or designed to be used as manufactured homes as defined in § 36-85.3 of the Code of Virginia)	\$0.79	+ \$0.52
3. Public Service Corporation Property	\$0.79	+ \$0.52
4. Tangible Personal Property Not Otherwise Exempt Or set out	\$3.65	+ \$3.15
5. Machinery & Tools	\$2.25	+ \$1.30
6. Aircraft	\$1.30	+ \$1.12

In place of the "split levy" method used in previous years to levy on property located in King William County, the Board of Supervisors proposes to adopt a uniform general property tax levy throughout the County for all county purposes and to deliver a pro rata share of the funds derived from such levy to the Town of West Point. The pro rata share will be determined in compliance with the formula set out in Section 22.1-114 of the Code of Virginia. The town share will then be subject to appropriation and expenditure by the Town Council as the Council deems appropriate. It is anticipated that approximately \$3,000,000 will be delivered to the Town pursuant to the formula for tax year 2013. This revenue to the Town of West Point will be in addition to any property taxes levied by the Town that Town Council deems necessary to provide for town services and town schools.

Proposed Ordinance #13-08 will repeal and replace Ordinance #13-04R, adopted on April 22, 2013, and establish the calendar year 2013 property tax levies throughout the County as set forth in this Notice, or as determined by the Board after the public hearing. The proposed tax levies listed in Ordinance #13-08 are the same as those adopted by the Board of Supervisors on April 22, 2013. The Board is repeating the public hearing and adoption process due to concerns that have been raised about the adequacy of the previous notice given.

All interested persons may appear and present their views at the above time and place. If a member of the public cannot attend, comments may be submitted by mail to P. O. Comments received by 12:00 noon on the day of the hearing will be distributed to Board members and made a part of the public record.
