

**KING WILLIAM COUNTY
PUBLIC NOTICE**

The King William County Board of Zoning Appeals will hold a Public Hearing on Tuesday, May 24, 2011 at 7:00 PM in the King William County Administration Building Board Room at 180 Horse Landing Road, King William Court House to consider the following matter:

Case SE-04-11: Steven Sturges (Owner/Applicant) Request for a Special Exception from Section 86-173 of the King William County Zoning Ordinance to construct a boat house on the Mattaponi River. The property is shown as Tax Map Parcel 22-108 on the King William County Tax Maps and zoned A-C (Agricultural-Conservation). The property is located at 13857 West River Road (State Route 600) in the Acquinton Magisterial District. The site is on the east side of State Route 600 approximately 2.5 miles south of the intersection of King William Road (State Route 30) and Richmond Tappahannock Highway (US Highway 360). The Land Use Plan designates this area as Agricultural-Conservation.

Anyone having an interest in this matter is invited to provide public hearing testimony before the Board of Zoning Appeals. Written testimony also will be accepted prior to the hearing, which may be directed to the Director of Community Development. All records pertaining to this matter are available for review during regular business hours in the Planning Department, located in the County Administration Building at 180 Horse Landing Road, King William, VA 23086.
