NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT AND PUBLIC HEARING**

**Proposed Amendment to Section 46-35  
of the King William County Code, Dangerous Devices**

The Board of Supervisors of King William County, Virginia will hold a Public Hearing on February 27, 2012, beginning at 7:00 p.m. in the Board Meeting Room of the County Administration Building, 180 Horse Landing Road, King William, Virginia to receive public comment and to consider adoption of an amendment to Section 46-35 of the King William County Code, entitled "Dangerous Devices".

The proposed amendment deletes the County's existing restrictions on the possession (carrying) of firearms and other guns in county owned recreational facilities and substitutes a prohibition on the discharge of firearms and other guns in such locations except in areas designated by the County and with the written permission of the County. The purpose is to comply with changes to state law.

All interested persons may appear and present their views at the above time and place. If a member of the public cannot attend, comments may be submitted by mail to P. O.
