

**KING WILLIAM COUNTY  
PUBLIC NOTICE**

**The King William County Board of Zoning Appeals will hold a Public Hearing on Tuesday, October 26, 2010 at 7:30 PM in the King William County Administration Building Board Room at 180 Horse Landing Road, King William Court House to consider the following matters:**

**Case SE-07-10 -- Owners/Applicants: Steve and Olivia Foreman -- Request a Special Exception from Section 86-664 (d)(4)a of the King William County Zoning Ordinance to create 2 lots less than five (5) acres in the A-C (Agricultural – Conservation) District for family members. The property is shown as Tax Map Parcels 18-3-1G, 18-3-1C, and 18-3-1B on the King William County Tax Maps and zoned A-C (Agricultural-Conservation). The property is located at 10301 Dabney’s Mill Road (State Route 604) in the Mangohick Magisterial District. The entrance to the site is approximately .35 miles south of the intersection with Dabney’s Mill Road (State Route 604) and Nelson’s Bridge Road (State Route 615). The Land Use Plan designates this parcel as Agricultural -Conservation.**

**Case: SE-08-10 -- Owners: James H and Shelia M. Banks; Applicant: Jamie S. Banks -- Request a Special Exception from Section 86-664(d)(4)a of the Zoning Ordinance to create a lot less than five (5) acres in the A-C (Agricultural-Conservation) District for a family member. The property is shown as Tax Map Parcel 21-21A on the King William County Tax Maps and zoned A-C (Agricultural-Conservation). The property is located at 9811 King William Road (State Route 30) in the Mangohick Magisterial District. The site is approximately one-half mile west of the intersection of King William Road (State Route 30) and Venter Road (State Route 611). The Land Use Plan designates this parcel as Agricultural-Conservation.**

**Anyone having an interest in these matters is invited to provide public hearing testimony before the Board of Zoning Appeals. Written testimony also will be accepted prior to the hearing, which may be directed to the Director of Community Development. All records pertaining to these matters are available for review during regular business hours in the Planning Department, located in the County Administration Building at 180 Horse Landing Road, King William, VA 23086.**
