King William County Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) - 12 Members, Variable Terms depending on Member Classification – Term will begin August 1, 2011.

King William County seeks persons to serve on the County's Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC). A County or Regional LEPC is required by the Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act of 1986. The Committees were initially established to develop comprehensive chemical emergency response plans. The King William County LEPC will help update and implement the County's Chemical Emergency Response Plan and also assist with the review, update and implementation of the County's Emergency Operations Plan and the Regional All Hazards Mitigation Plan. The group may also assist, as requested, with Emergency Operation Center and Emergency Shelter activities during pre, actual and post emergency events.

Terms will vary depending on member classification. All members serve at the pleasure of the Board of Supervisors. Law Enforcement, Local Government and Industrial Representatives are proposed to have indefinite terms. The balance of members will initially have 2-4 year terms such that staggered terms of 4 years can be utilized in the future in an attempt to prevent turnover of more than 50% of the LEPC members.
