

**KING WILLIAM COUNTY  
PUBLIC NOTICE**

**The King William County Board of Zoning Appeals will hold a Public Hearing on Tuesday, August 31, 2010 at 7:30 PM in the King William County Administration Building Board Room at 180 Horse Landing Road, King William Court House to consider the following matters:**

**Case SE-06-07 -- (Owner: Mangohick Volunteer Fire Department; Applicant: Rick Crabtree, President) -- Request for Renewal of a Special Exception from Section 86-664(9)a-b of the King William County Zoning Ordinance to operate a Turkey Shoot in the A-C (Agricultural-Conservation) District at 3493 King William Road (State Route 30). The parcel is shown as Tax Map Parcel 11-59A on the King William County Tax Maps and located in the Mangohick Magisterial District. The entrance to the site is approximately 1/10 of a mile south of the intersection of State Route 604 (Dabney's Mill Road) and State Route 30 (King William Road). The Land Use Plan designates this parcel as Agricultural-Conservation.**

**Case: SE-05-10 -- (Owner: Clara B. Powell; Applicant: Wayne and Valerie Murray) -- Request a Special Exception from Section 86-664(c)(1) of the King William County Zoning Ordinance to construct a second home on a parcel of land that is smaller than fifty (50) acres. The property is shown as Tax Map Parcel 14-14A on the King William County Tax Maps and zoned A-C (Agricultural-Conservation). The property is located at 1611 Upshaw Road (State Route 608) in the Mangohick Magisterial District. The site is approximately ½ mile east of the intersection of State Route 608 (Upshaw Road) and State Route 607 (Beadles Road). The Land Use Plan designates this parcel as Agricultural-Conservation.**

**Anyone having an interest in these matters is invited to provide public hearing testimony before the Board of Zoning Appeals. Written testimony also will be accepted prior to the hearing, which may be directed to the Director of Community Development. All records pertaining to these matters are available for review during regular business hours in the Planning Department, located in the County Administration Building at 180 Horse Landing Road, King William, VA 23086.**
