This notice is to remind all citizens that April 1, 2012 to May 31, 2012 is county-wide leash law. All citizens must keep their dogs contained during this time. Leash law means that no dog shall be permitted to run at large in any part of the county. All dogs shall be confined, restricted, or penned up during these months. A dog shall be deemed to be running at large while roaming, running, or self-hunting off the property of its owner or custodian and not under the owner or custodian's immediate control.
