

**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABANDON A SECTION OF STATE ROUTE 633  
(POWHATAN TRAIL) AND PUBLIC HEARING**

Pursuant to Section 33.1-151 of the Code of Virginia, notice is hereby given that the King William County Board of Supervisors intends to abandon a segment of State Route 633 (Powhatan Trail) located between its intersection with State Route 673 (Pocahontas Trail) and the Norfolk Southern right of way, a distance of 197.50 feet (0.036 mile) and will hold a public hearing on Monday, October 22, 2012 at 7:30 pm in the Board of Supervisors Meeting Room, located in the County Administration Building, 180 Horse Landing Road, King William, Virginia, to receive public comment on such abandonment. This is a rescheduled public hearing originally planned for September 24, 2012.

The public is invited to attend the public hearing and comment on the proposed intention to abandon. Information on the proposed abandonment of State Route 633 (Powhatan Trail), including a plan depicting the abandonment, can be inspected at the King William County Administration office, 180 Horse Landing Road, King William, VA 23086 between the hours of 8:30 am and 4:30 pm Monday through Friday.
