

# NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

## COUNTY OF KING WILLIAM

### PROPOSED COUNTY CODE AMENDMENT RECORDATION AND PROBATE TAXES

Pursuant to Sections 15.2-1427, 58.1-1718 and 58.1-3800 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, the Board of Supervisors of King William County, Virginia, shall conduct a public hearing on Monday, August 23, 2010, at 7:00 p.m. in the Board Meeting Room of the King William County Administration Building at King William Court House to receive public comment and to consider the following proposed amendment to Chapter 70 of the King William County Code entitled "Taxation" to add the following sections:

#### TAX ON PROBATE OF WILLS OR GRANT OF ADMINISTRATION

Section 70.6 There is hereby imposed, on the probate of every will or grant of administration not exempt by law, a County tax in amount of one-third of the state tax on such probate of a will or grant of administration and a \$25 fee for the recordation of a list of heirs, as set forth in sections 58.1-1712, 58.1-1717.1 and 58.1-3805.

#### RECORDATION TAX

Section 70.7 There is hereby imposed a recordation tax, in an amount equal to one-third of the amount of the state recordation tax collectible for the Commonwealth, as set forth in section 58.1-814.

The Board of Supervisors may establish time limits for speakers and other rules governing the conduct of the public hearing.
